6:30-7:00 pm Set-up for the dance

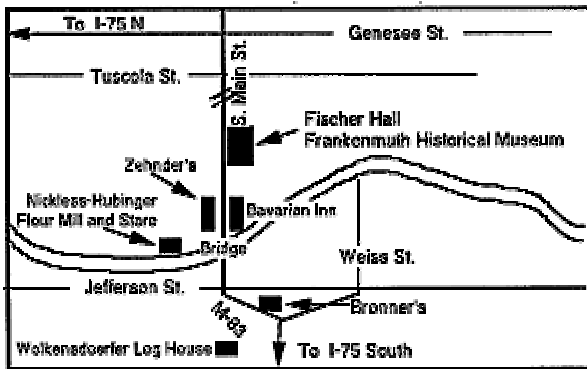
